Minutes of the regular meeting of the Hobbs City Commission held on Monday, December 5, 2022, in the City Commission Chamber, 200 East Broadway, 1st Floor Annex, Hobbs, New Mexico. This meeting was also viewable to the public via Livestream on the City's website at <u>www.hobbsnm.org</u>.

Call to Order and Roll Call

Mayor Cobb called the meeting to order at 6:00 p.m. and welcomed everyone to the meeting. The City Clerk called the roll and the following answered present:

<u>Resolution No. 7281 – Authorizing the City of Hobbs to Enter Into a Memorandum of</u> <u>Agreement with Lea County Accepting an Appropriation of \$250,000.00 for the City of</u> <u>Hobbs Spay and Neuter Program</u>

Hobbs Police Captain Marina Barrientes and Ms. Missy Funk, Manager of the Hobbs Animal Adoption Center (HAAC), presented a Memorandum of Agreement to the Commission between the City and Lea County accepting an appropriation of \$250,000.00 from Lea County. The purpose of this Memorandum of Agreement is to memorialize the terms and provisions regarding Lea County's grant of \$250,000.00 for operational and capital expenditures to expand the spay and neuter programs and services in the City.

Commissioner Penick expressed great appreciation to County Commissioner Rebecca Long for these funds which will greatly benefit the Hobbs Animal Adoption Center. In response to a question from Commissioner Penick, Ms. Funk stated there is additional funding of \$50,000.00 from Lea County for cleaning services at the HAAC.

Mr. Manny Gomez, City Manager, thanked City staff for their work at the HAAC.

Commissioner Fields thanked Animal Control for their quick response when he recently hit an animal in the roadway.

There being no further discussion, Commissioner Penick moved that Resolution No. 7281 be adopted as presented. Commissioner Gerth seconded the motion and the vote was recorded as follows: Smith yes, Mills yes, Fields yes, Calderón yes, Penick yes, Gerth yes, Cobb yes. The motion carried. Copies of the resolution and agreement are attached and made a part of these minutes.

<u>Resolution No. 7282 – Authorizing the Retention Incentive for the Hobbs Police</u> <u>Department Beginning December 2022 Through June 2023</u>

Mr. August Fons, Police Chief, stated the City of Hobbs Commission approved an allocation disbursement on November 7, 2022, from the Department of Finance and Administration (DFA) in the amount of \$4,987,500.00. DFA has approved expenditures out of this fund for hiring, recruiting and retention purposes. Chief Fons stated the Hobbs Police Department (HPD) hopes to incentivize police officers to remain employed with the department and in doing so, would recommend a retention incentive that will be funded by the DFA allocation. He explained HPD would offer a monthly retention Incentive to every officer who meets the eligibility requirements pursuant to HPD and HB68 in the amount of \$1,750.00 per month less applicable taxes. Chief Fons stated the monthly incentive period would begin on December 1, 2022, and would end on June 10, 2023. He stated he believes it would have a positive impact on the department.

Commissioners Gerth and Penick commented this is a great opportunity for officers.

Mayor Cobb agreed and stated it will be another tool in the tool kit to help recruit and retain officers at HPD.

There being no further discussion, Commissioner Calderón moved that Resolution No. 7282 be adopted as presented. Commissioner Fields seconded the motion and the vote was recorded as follows: Smith yes, Mills yes, Fields yes, Calderón yes, Penick yes, Gerth yes, Cobb yes. The motion carried. A copy of the resolution and supporting documentation are attached and made a part of these minutes.

<u>PUBLIC HEARING: Resolution No. 7283 – Regarding the Transfer of Ownership of Liquor</u> <u>License No. 2584 from Jitter Enterprises, LLC, to Hobbs Oil Patch Inn, LLC, d/b/a Hobbs</u> <u>Family Inn Derrick Lounge and Saxony Steak Room Located at 501 North Marland, Hobbs,</u> <u>New Mexico</u>

Mayor Cobb appointed Mr. Efren Cortez, City Attorney, as the Hearing Officer to conduct the public hearing.

Mr. Cortez stated the purpose of the hearing is to consider the application for transfer of ownership of Liquor License No. 2584 from Jitter Enterprises, LLC, to Hobbs Oil Patch Inn, LLC, d/b/a Hobbs Family Inn Derrick Lounge and Saxony Steak Room located at 501 North Marland, Hobbs, New Mexico. He stated notice of the public hearing was published in the Hobbs News Sun on November 4, 2022, and November 11, 2022.

Mr. Cortez asked if anyone was present at the public hearing regarding the application. Mr. Robbie Roberts stated he was appearing tonight on behalf of Hobbs Oil Patch Inn, LLC. No other individuals came forward to speak.

Ms. Jan Fletcher, City Clerk, administered an oath to Mr. Robbie Roberts so that he could offer his testimony.

Mr. Cortez stated the State of New Mexico Alcoholic Beverage Control has granted preliminary approval to the application for the transfer of ownership of the liquor license. He stated a public hearing has to be held within 45 days of receipt of the application on whether or not the transfer of the proposed liquor license should be granted.

Mr. Cortez stated the application can be denied for only three reasons which are as follows: (1) if the location is within 300 feet of a church or school, which is not applicable here; (2) if it is in violation of a zoning or other ordinance of the governing body, which is not applicable here; and (3) if the issuance would be detrimental to the public health, safety or morals of the residents of the local option district. Mr. Cortez further stated disapproval by the governing body on public health, safety or morals must be based on and supported by substantial evidence pertaining to the specific prospective transferee or locations and a copy of the record must be submitted to the Alcoholic Beverage Control.

Mr. Cortez requested clarification to the record that the new CTECH Facility at the Hobbs High School is more than 300' from the licensed premises. Following this clarification, Mr. Roberts testified that all the statements made by Mr. Cortez are true and correct to his knowledge.

Mr. Roberts stated the Hobbs Oil Patch Inn had previously sold its license to Jitter Enterprises in 2019. After a default on that purchase agreement, Hobbs Oil Patch Inn has resumed operation of the facility and is currently leasing the liquor license until the official transfer paperwork with the State and City have been completed.

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In response to Commissioner Smith's question, Mr. Cortez stated the City is the Local Option District and its primary concern in the liquor license transfer process is the location and health, safety and welfare of the citizens. He stated the rest of the process is handled by the State of New Mexico Regulation and Licensing Department.

In further response to a follow-up inquiry by Commissioner Smith, Mr. Roberts stated the default process has been concluded and Hobbs Oil Patch Inn has reclaimed ownership of the property. Once the City has approved the transfer of ownership, the State will then issue its final approval on the process.

There being no further discussion, Commissioner Calderón moved that Resolution No. 7283 be adopted approving the transfer of ownership of Liquor License No. 2584. Commissioner Penick seconded the motion and the vote was recorded as follows: Smith yes, Mills yes, Fields yes, Calderón yes, Penick yes, Gerth yes, Cobb yes. The motion carried. A copy of the resolution and supporting documentation are attached and made a part of these minutes.

<u>Resolution No. 7284 – Approving a Development Agreement with Lemke Development,</u> Inc., Concerning the Development of Market Rate Single-Family Housing

Prior to discussion of this item, Mr. Robinson presented a brief history and review of the Hobbs Market Rate Multi-Family & Single Family Housing Municipal Infrastructure Reimbursement Incentive and Public Participation Infrastructure Extension Development Agreement Policy. He stated a total of 2,314 new unit have been produced as a result of the City's reimbursement incentives.

Mr. Robinson described the impact these units have had on the local economy. A copy of his PowerPoint presentation is attached to these minutes for reference.

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A brief discussion was held on the assumptions used when making these type of calculations.

Commissioner Smith stated more housing inventory is being created and growing the population of the City.

Commissioner Penick stated he definitely supports the City's program.

Mayor Cobb thanked Mr. Robinson for the information and asked him to proceed with the agenda item.

Mr. Robinson stated Lemke Development, Inc., has requested a Development Agreement with the City concerning the development of single-family housing units located within the municipal boundaries. He stated the developer proposes to produce market rate single-family units and is requesting infrastructure incentives of \$100,000.00. Mr. Robinson stated Mr. John Lemke is present in the audience if the Commissioners have any questions.

Mayor Cobb thanked Mr. Lemke for being here tonight.

In response to Mayor Cobb's question, Mr. Robinson stated while the Development Agreement is not specific to a certain location, he displayed a map of Meadows/Meadowlands area which is being developed.

Following some brief comments, Commissioner Penick moved that Resolution No. 7284 be adopted as presented. Commissioner Penick seconded the motion and the vote was recorded as follows: Smith yes, Mills yes, Fields yes, Calderón yes, Penick yes, Gerth yes, Cobb yes. The motion carried. Copies of the resolution and supporting documentation are attached and made a part of these minutes.

<u>Resolution No. 7285 – Approving an Infrastructure Extension Development Agreement</u> with Stuard Homes, LLC, Concerning the Development of Public Infrastructures

Mr. Robinson stated Stuard Homes, LLC, has requested a public participation Infrastructure Development Agreement concerning the projection of Calle Grande (+/-596 Lin. Ft.) from the existing terminus north to the developer's north property line. He stated the Development Agreement would allow for the partial reimbursement of costs to the developer, upon certification by the Engineer of Record, in an amount not to exceed \$123,372.00, provided said infrastructures are installed and certified within 550 days of ratification of the Agreement. Mr. Robinson explained the Development Agreement will place an assessment equal to the amount of public participation on those properties adjacent to the emplacements requiring the Developer to pay the assessment at time of development, subdivision or conveyance.

Following a brief discussion, Commissioner Fields moved that Resolution No. 7285 be adopted as presented. Commissioner Mills seconded the motion and the vote was recorded as follows: Smith yes, Mills yes, Fields yes, Calderón yes, Penick yes, Gerth yes, Cobb yes. The motion carried. Copies of the resolution and supporting documentation are attached and made a part of these minutes.

COMMENTS BY CITY COMMISSIONERS, CITY MANAGER

Mr. Gomez announced that Ms. Sandy Farrell, Library Director, will be leaving the City of Hobbs after 11 years of dedicated service. He expressed appreciation to Ms. Farrell for her hard work and extended well wishes in her future endeavors.

Mr. Gomez stated it has been a busy time for City staff. He reported on the Toys for Tots Tournament which had many attendees. He stated the Christmas Parade was held Saturday and the Tree Lighting Ceremony was held on Saturday evening. Mr. Gomez thanked City staff for their work in making these events successful.

Ms. Meghan Mooney, Communications Director, reported on the Tree Lighting Ceremony. She also thanked the Tree Lighting Committee and City staff for their assistance with this big event. She stated attendance at the event was estimated at 7,000-8,000 attendees and it is increasing every year, even though less money was spent on advertising the event than in the past. Ms. Mooney stated it is a free event for the public to attend. Donations of \$800.00 were collected for the Hobbs Professional Firefighters Association for the HFD Toy Drive. Ms. Mooney thanked all of the sponsors and volunteers for the event, including the Hobbs High School Student Council.

Commissioner Penick thanked Ms. Mooney for all of her time and efforts in coordinating this event. He also thanked City staff for their work and stated it was an awesome event for the community.

Commissioner Gerth gave kudos to City staff for their time and work on all of the events,

Commissioner Mills stated the Christmas Parade had great Christmas spirit with many City employees, departments and the community taking a part in it.

Commissioner Fields thanked Ms. Mooney for her hard work. He agreed that the Christmas events have lifted everyone's spirits and have brought such warmth and gladness to his heart. Commissioner Fields stated the City is very blessed to have a great City staff and City Manager.

Commissioner Calderón stated the parade was great and two citizens even assisted him in getting across the street.

Mayor Cobb also thanked everyone for their support and encouragement following his recent surgery.





The Director of the Alcoholic Beverage Control Division (ABC) has reviewed the referenced Application and granted Preliminary Approval. It is being forwarded to you for Local Option District approval or disapproval of the Liquor License Application.

Notice of the Public Hearing required by the Liquor Control Act shall be given by the governing body by publishing a notice of the date, time, and place of the hearing twice during the 30 days prior to the hearing in a newspaper of general circulation within the territorial limits of the governing body. The first notice must be published at least thirty (30) days before the hearing. Both publications must occur before a hearing can be conducted. The notice shall include:

- (A) Name and address of the Applicant/Licensee;
- (B) The action proposed to be taken;
- (C) The location of the licensed premises.

In addition, if the Local Option District has a website, the Notice shall also be published on the website.

While the law states that "within forty-five (45) days after receipt of a Notice from the Alcoholic Beverage Control, the governing body shall hold a Public Hearing in the question of whether the department should approve the proposed issuance or transfer", we recognize the potential for conflict between the requirement for publication of 30 day notice and the 45 day hearing requirement.

With that in mind, when a local governing body receives a liquor license application from ABC, that governing body has a couple of options:

- 1) Hold a hearing on the license application within the statutory time frame of forty-five (45) days, as required by the Liquor Control Act, and comply with all other statutory and regulatory procedures and notify ABC of your decision within thirty (30) days of the hearing;
- 2) Request from ABC an extension of time, past the forty-five (45) days, designating how much additional time will be needed to conduct the hearing in compliance with all statutory and regulatory procedures. After the extension is granted and the hearing is held, notify ABC of your decision within thirty (30) days of the hearing;

ABC has no preference in the option you choose.

The governing body is required to send notice by certified mail to the Applicant of the date, time, and place of the Public Hearing. The governing body may designate a Hearing Officer to conduct the hearing. A record shall be made of the hearing.

THE APPLICANT IS SEEKING RESTAURANT A – BEER AND WINE LIQUOR LICENSE WITH ON PREMISES CONSUMPTION ONLY

Within thirty (30) days after the Public Hearing, the governing body shall notify ABC of their decision to approve or disapprove the issuance or transfer of the license by signing the enclosed original Page 1 of the Application. The original Page 1 of the Application must be returned together with the notices of publication. If the Governing Body fails to either approve or disapprove the issuance or transfer of the license within thirty days after the Public Hearing, the Director may issue the license.


If the Governing Body disapproves the issuance or transfer of the license, it shall notify ABC within thirty (30) days setting forth the reasons for the disapproval. A copy of the Minutes of the Public Hearing shall be submitted to ABC with the Notice of Disapproval (*Page 1 of the Application, noting disapproval*).




