#### Invocation and Pledge of Allegiance

#### **Proclamations and Awards of Merit**

Mayor Cobb proclaimed Monday, December 4, 2023, as *"Hobbs Eagles Varsity Soccer Day"*. He stated the Hobbs Eagles Varsity Soccer Team had a successful year with a perfect 23-0 record and winning the 2023 NMAA 5A State Soccer Championship. He stated Coach Reyes Marquez, and Assistant Coaches Esteban Sotelo, Chris Middleton, Melvon Anders and Louis Vega led this year's team to believe in themselves and instilled a high level of confidence that took their team to a State Championship.

#### **Public Comments**

Mr. August Fons, Police Chief, stated the City has received several complaints recently regarding the brightness of digital sign billboards around town. Chief Fons stated not only were the digital signs too bright and in violation of the Hobbs Municipal Code but they are also a distraction to drivers. Code Enforcement issued 8 warnings to the sign owners, four of whom agreed to dim the lights on the signs. Chief Fons stated he wanted the Commission to know how the warnings originated and that any distractions to drivers creates a safety hazard in the community.

Mr. Todd Randall, City Engineer, explained the amendment for an extension of the grant agreement expiration date to December 31, 2024. Mr. Randall stated the design of the project is complete and the City Commission approved the equipment purchase on August 21, 2023. Delivery of the equipment has been delayed and is not anticipated to be received until the second quarter of 2024.

#### Consideration of Approval of Project Award for Bid No. 1606-24 Hobbs CDBG Infrastructure Improvements and Recommendation to Award Bid Lot 1 to Ramirez & Sons, Inc., in the Amount of \$983,366.00

Mr. Todd Randall, City Engineer explained Bid No. 1606-24 for Hobbs CDBG infrastructure Improvements. He described the project area and Mr. Randall stated bids were received from Ramirez & Sons Inc., Constructors, Inc and J & H Service, Inc. Mr. Randall stated the bid of Ramirez & Sons, Inc., was the lowest bid for Bid Lot 1 at a cost of \$983,366.00. He explained the reason for the delay in the bid award was because all contractors and sub-contractors must have an active Federal SAM's registration. Also, the New Mexico Department of Labor requires every public works project over \$60,000.00 must have a wage decision from the State of New Mexico. Mr. Randall stated the bid award needs to occur prior to expiration of the wage decision on December 14, 2023, or the project will potentially have to re-bid. It is City staff's recommendation to award Bid Lot 1 of the project to Ramirez & Sons, Inc., in the amount of \$983,336.00.

Commissioner Penick commented on several outstanding purchase orders for Ramirez & Sons, Inc., and the importance of getting previous projects completed before approving the bid on a new one. He stated Ramirez & Sons, Inc., does quality work but waiting a year or two for projects to be completed is too long.

In response to Commissioner Fields' question, Mr. Randall described the project area and the additional cost involved to expand the area.

Following the discussion, Commissioner Calderón moved that Bid No. 1606-24 be awarded to Ramirez & Sons, Inc., for Bid Lot 1 in the amount of \$983,366.00. Commissioner Fields seconded the motion and the vote was recorded as follows: Penick yes, Calderón yes, Fields yes, Mills yes, Cobb yes. The motion carried. 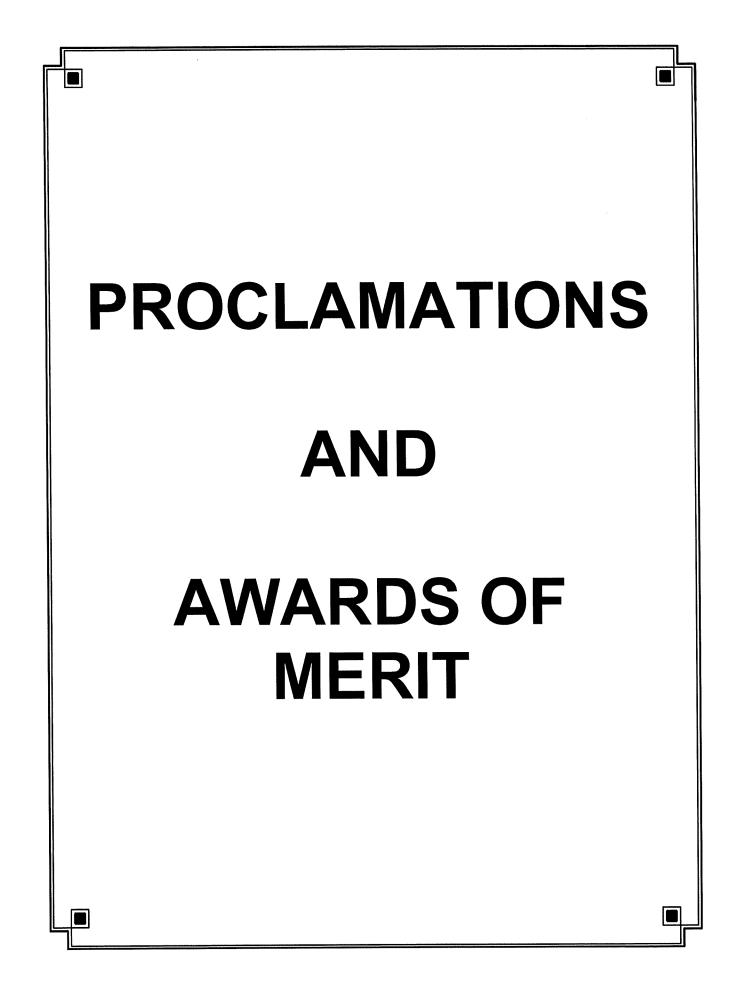

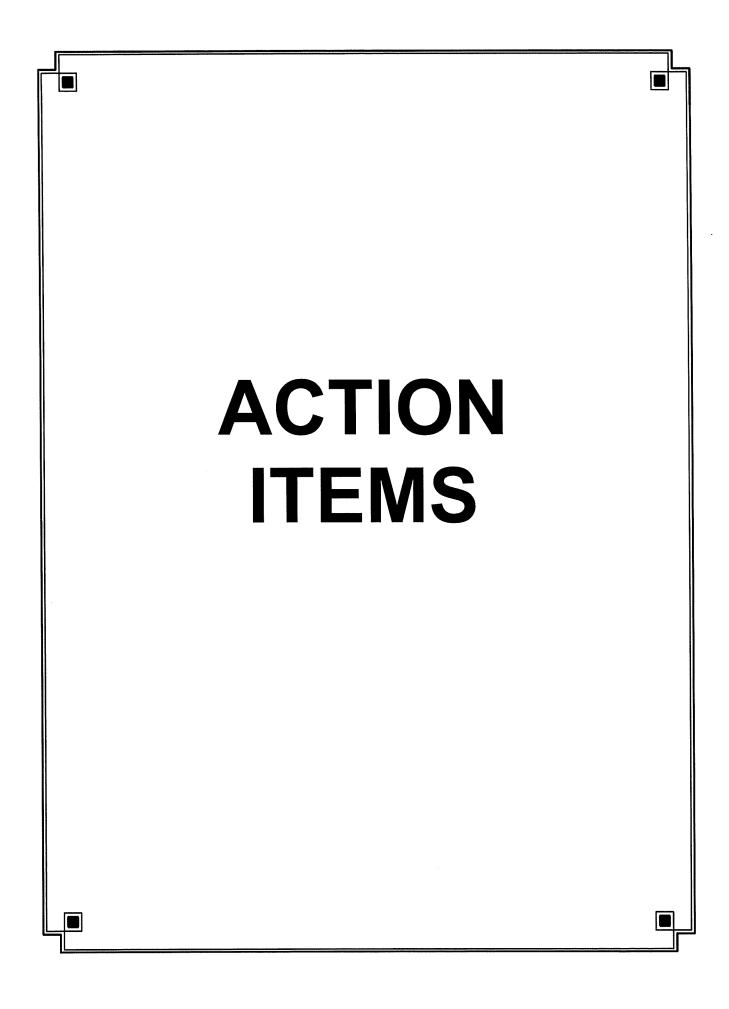

The Police Department, Information Technology Division is requesting to replace the Police Department Annex (301 N. Dalmont St.) fire alarm system. The new system will replace all wiring and all new hardware consisting of pull stations, strobe lights, heat detectors, main alarm panel and five annunciators. It will provide significant fire alarm monitoring in the jail area, including monitoring the jail kitchen hood fire suppression system.
