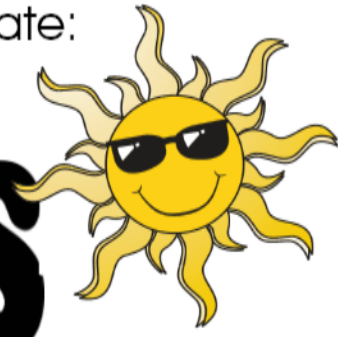


City of Hobbs Parks & Recreation Presents our save the Date:

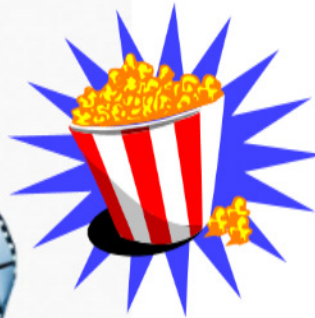

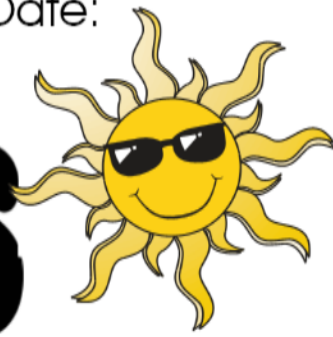

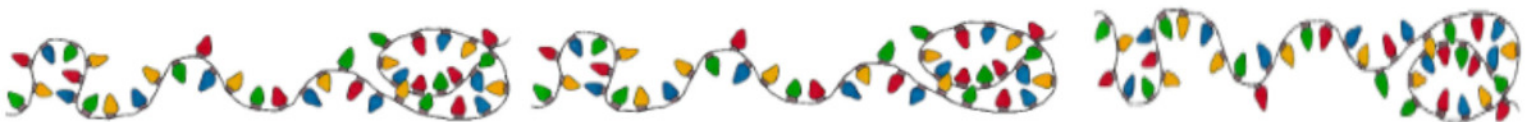
