

### **Specialty Class Policy**

1. Senior Citizens who are members of the Hobbs Senior Citizen Center may sign up in advance of community registration, with limited enrollment (one half of enrollment is designated for Senior Citizen participants), by phoning the Hobbs Senior Center. A waiting list will be established after the advance enrollment is full. Those seniors on the waiting list are encouraged to come to the community registration.
2. To qualify for the Senior Citizens' class fee, you must be a member of the Senior Center, or be 62 years of age or older.
3. If a participant missed one of their scheduled class times, they can not go to another class and make it up.
4. Determination of whether a class will or will not make, will be finalized on the Thursday before the first week of class.
5. No refunds will be given after determining that the class will make.
6. Participants wishing to transfer will be dealt with on an individual basis.
7. Participants may sign themselves up and one another. Additional individuals will be placed on a waiting list and will be called if any opening are available.
8. The class limit is set by the Recreation Division and each individual instructor. No exceptions to the class limit can be made by the instructors. Classes will not be held if they do not meet the minimum class limit set by the Recreation Division.

These policies may be changed or added to at the discretion of the City Manager and Recreation Division.
