NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that on the 5th day of June, 2017, the governing body of the City of Hobbs adopted an ordinance repealing Resolution 5329 Code of Ethics/Related Party Policy for the City of Hobbs and adopted an Ordinance amending Chapter 2 of the Hobbs Municipal Code which shall be The City of Hobbs Code of Conduct.
